Cook Forest Selfie Scavenger Hunt

1. Seneca Point: See "Indian mills," unnatural indentations in stones used to grind grains and a spectacular view.
2. Fire Tower: Enjoy a commanding view of the Clarion River Valley below from the 87.5-foot fire tower.
3. Forest Cathedral: Stands of old-growth forest with towering white pines and hemlocks that are designated as a National Natural Landmark.
4. Clarion River: The Clarion River meanders through the narrow valleys and forested with riffles and rock outcrops that provide a picturesque backdrop for outdoor recreation.
5. Blue Whale at Pale Whale Canoe Fleet: Kayaks, canoes, tubes, and river rafts on the Clarion River on River Road. Restrooms, changing rooms, cabins, gift shop, and cafe.
6. Giant bear at Parker's Indian Trading Post: Panning for gems, gifts, souvenirs, moccasins, toys, jewelry, Native American items, knives, leather goods, hats, and T-shirts.
7. A bridge at Clear Creek State Park: 1,900 acres in a deep and scenic valley. Perfect for hiking and camping with Clarion River access.
8. Beartown Rocks: Massive house-sized boulders, created by glaciers, with breathtaking scenic views and hiking trails.
9. Louis Painter Memorial Trout Nursery: Come feed these fish. The Heath Township Sportsman's Club raises trout for a kids' fishing derby each May at Clear Creek State Park and to stock local streams.
10. Goats at Farmer's Inn: Wildlife Park includes a petting zoo, native and exotic animals, a driving range, miniature golf courses, restaurant, and gift shop.
