Forest County Selfie Scavenger Hunt

1. Peace Park: On Lighthouse Island featuring a Cross of Freedom, Statue of Liberty, Veterans Memorial, Chapel, and replica scale model of 1893 Timber Crib dam.
2. Tionesta Market Village: This "Mini Main Street" offers a unique shopping experience for handcrafted items in relaxed setting.
3. Forest County History Center: 1875 Victorian Eastlake-style home filled with artifacts from Native Americans and early settlers, tools, products from county businesses, genealogies of local families, and a replica lumber camp.
4. Tionesta Lake: Six miles long with more than 3,000 acres for unlimited horsepower boating, fishing, and camping.
5. Marienville Ranger Station: Explore hundreds of miles of trails designated for hiking, bicycling, horseback riding, and ATV adventures.
6. Buzzard Swamp: 15 ponds with 11.2 miles of trails offering exceptional wildlife viewing. Important link on the Atlantic flyway waterfowl migration path.
7. Frog Rock: A large rock resembling a frog in Tionesta Creek can be seen from Route 666 "The Devil's Highway".
8. Hunter's Station Overlook: Educational historic panels on design elements of the 1934 bridge, river history, Seneca Nation, archeological discoveries, and endangered mussels relocation, along with a piece of the original bridge.
9. Forest County Courthouse: Completed July 1870 for \$24,715. 1884 murals of Lady Justice and Lady Liberty were restored in 2006.
10. Loleta Recreation Area: 38 tent sites along the east branch of Millstone Creek some with electric, picnic tables, and fire ring.
